ORDINANCE NO. 2794

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF SULPHUR SPRINGS, TEXAS RESTRICTING PARKING ON EAST SHANNON ROAD; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Sec. 25-82 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Sulphur Springs, Texas authorizes the Chief of Police to cause areas and streets of the City to be designated as no parking zones when directed to do so by the City Council and to erect signs in such areas so designated; and

WHEREAS, in order to ensure the health, safety and welfare of motorized and pedestrian traffic in and over the streets and roadways the City Council must limit or prohibit parking in certain areas where parking would dangerously impede traffic; and

WHEREAS, The City Council of the City of Sulphur Springs, Texas finds that it is necessary to restrict parking on East Shannon Road.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SULPHUR SPRINGS, TEXAS:

Chapter 25 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Sulphur Springs is hereby amended by adding Section 25-82.2 as follows:

Sec. 25-82.2 Prohibited Parking on East Shannon Road

1. Parking of vehicles on the south side of East Shannon Road is hereby prohibited between South Broadway Street and Mockingbird Lane.
2. All traffic maps of the City shall hereby be amended to reflect this ordinance.
3. Any person violating any provision of this ordinance or of Chapter 25 of the Code of Ordinances generally shall be guilty of a Class "C" misdemeanor, and upon conviction shall be fined in a sum not to exceed \$500.00.
4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby expressly repealed.
5. If any section, subsection or sentence or phrase of this ordinance is declared to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, it shall not affect the validity of this ordinance.

6. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.
